



**STATEMENT ON EUROPEAN UNION RoHS RECAST DIRECTIVE 2011/65/EU
AND DELEGATED DIRECTIVE 2015/863 CONCERNING
RESTRICTION OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES (RoHS)**

Vulcan Steel Products, Inc. (Vulcan) is not regulated under RoHS for its domestic shipments of steel products but understands that its customers may benefit from having this information. The information provided below is based on commercially reasonable efforts and applies to substances included as of the Policy date listed below. Concentration levels are based upon the total weight of the steel products at the time they ship from Vulcan. Products excluded from this statement are those manufactured to customer specification and directive.

Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS Recast or RoHS 2)

RoHS Recast restricts the use of the following six hazardous substances in the manufacture of various types of electrical and electronic equipment at maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials: lead – 0.1%; mercury – 0.1%; cadmium – 0.01%; hexavalent chromium – 0.1%; polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) – 0.1%; and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) – 0.1%.

To the best of Vulcan's belief and based upon information currently available, the steel products as shipped from Vulcan's facility do not contain any of these six substances above the relevant concentration or beyond the relevant scope of restriction

Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 (RoHS 3)

Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 became effective in July 2019. Directive 2015/863 restricts the use of the following four additional hazardous substances: bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) – 0.1%; butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) – 0.1%; dibutyl phthalate (DBP) – 0.1%; and diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) – 0.1%.

To the best of Vulcan's belief and based upon information currently available, the steel products as shipped from Vulcan's facility do not contain any these four substances above the relevant concentration or beyond the relevant scope of restriction
